Thailand, as the host of APEC 2022, is ready to host the 11th APEC Tourism Ministerial Meeting and the 60th APEC Tourism Working Group Meeting in Bangkok from 14-20 August, 2022. The meetings will be held with a 'Low-carbon' approach under the concept of 'Regenerative Tourism' that promotes sustainable recovery postpandemic.

The concept of 'Regenerative Tourism' focuses on a holistic approach to develop and promote tourism by taking into account all possible impacts on the environment, culture, and the local way of life. As well as restoration of tourist attractions, the strategy places emphasis on sustainable tourism development by balancing tourist numbers to suit the attraction, and more importantly, prioritising on providing service quality and consistency over the number of tourists. The aim also is to encourage local people to participate in and benefit from inclusive and equitable tourism, and to stimulate awareness on cultural and environmental preservation.

This is in line with the Royal Thai Government's Bio-Circular-Green or BCG Economy Model, which is being used to revive Thailand's tourism industry with the aim for safe, inclusive, and sustainable travel.
