## 'Top 100 Beaches on Earth 2023'

Koh Kradan is a small island known for its stunning beaches located in Trang Province. With crystal-clear waters, soft white sands, and shallow reefs teeming with brain corals, antler corals, red spiny soft corals, and various fish species, it's no wonder that Koh Kradan boasts some of the most beautiful beaches in the Trang Sea and rank the first place of 100 beaches on earth 2023 by the UK website World Beach Guide.

Furthermore, there are four other Thai beaches that listed in the Top 100 for 2023, Railay Beach in Krabi province (9th), Freedom Beach in Phuket (18th), Laem Beach on Yao Yai Island in Phang-nga province (21st) and Tanot Bay Beach on Ko Tao of Surat Thani (44th).

- 1.Bang Krachao, Samut Prakan Enjoy biking or kayaking under the shades, and sampling delicious local dishes.
- 2. Phetchaburi Old Community, Phetchaburi Walk through the old town for their delicious food, visit the Nang Yai (shadow puppets) museum at Wat Phlapphla Chai, and join their workshop.
- 3. Ban Na Wa, Nakhon Phanom Learn indigo tie-dying and Thai Yor-style fabric weaving.
- 4. Ban Tha Ranae, Trat Cruise along or replenish the mangrove forest, learn about natural dying using 'taboon' plant (Xylocarpus granatum).
- 5. Ban Pa Miang, Lampang Visit an Assum tea plantation, and learn all about tea and its multiple edible uses.
